By London Underground

Nearest stations: Central and Jubilee lines to Bond Street (less than 10 minutes walk) or Victoria, Bakerloo and Central lines to Oxford Circus (less than 10 minutes walk).

By bus

Nearest bus routes: 6, 7, 10, 13, 15, 23, 25, 30, 55, 73, 94, 98, 113, 137, 139, 159, 175, 189, 274, 390 are all within walking distance to Chandos House.
